



CASPR Non-Member Volunteer Policy

Introduction

CASPR relies on the work of member volunteers and non-member volunteers and values all of their contributions highly.

Purpose

This policy is intended to ensure that non-member volunteers assisting **CASPR** have work that is safe, significant, fulfilling, and appreciated.

Definition

A non-member volunteer is defined as a former or retired **CASPR** member who wishes to continue to support the organization through committee participation. We reserve the right to approve any volunteers wanting to join the organization's committees.

Policy

All non-member volunteers shall be treated with respect and gratitude for their contribution. Non-member volunteers shall carry out duties assigned by the Board or Committee Chairs of **CASPR**. **CASPR** wishes non-member volunteers to become involved in committees in order to enhance the scale and scope of the work that is being undertaken. Non-member volunteers will be voting members on committees, however non-voting at Board meetings or the Annual General Meeting. Non-member volunteers will not have access to the CASPR Executive area of the CASPR website.
